Our field trips are designed to give students K-8 a ninety-minute immersive experience at the Growing Minds Educational Farm. Each field trip consists of a one-hour discovery walk around the farm where students will learn about our beehives, grape vines, food forest, hydroponics and more! Our discovery walk is followed by thirty minutes of exploration time in our STEM outdoor learning lab.

What do students do on the field trip and do you have any follow up classroom activities?

While learning about our sustainable practices students will meet also meet our resident goats, chickens and ducks as well as observe our honeybee hives from a distance. Students will have the opportunity to feed the livestock before visiting our outdoor classroom where students will participate in a planting activity that they will be able to take back to their school or home and continue to nurture and grow. Don't worry though it is packaged up nice and neat for travel so there will be no dirt on the bus. Finally, each field trip concludes with exploration time in our STEM outdoor learning lab which can be seen by scanning the above QR code. Our standard based curriculum and instruction is delivered by certified agriculture teacher and principal, Katie Donohoe.

When, where and how much?

Field trips are typically offered from 10:00 am -11:30 am during the school year but other days and times are available by request. Our address is 3050 Grape Lane Mount Pleasant, SC 29466. Classes are welcome to bring a bagged lunch to enjoy at the farm after the field trip. Our non-profit asks for a \$8 donation per student for field trips of 25 or more students.
