What do students do on the field trip?

While learning about our sustainable practices, students will also meet our resident goats and chickens. Students will have the opportunity to feed the goats before visiting our outdoor classroom where students will participate in a planting activity that they will be able to take back to their school or home and continue to nurture and grow. Don't worry though it is packaged up nice and neat for travel so there will be no dirt on the bus. After our one hour farm tour and animal visit, students will have thirty minutes to explore our Outdoor Learning Lab. Our standard based curriculum and instruction is delivered by certified agriculture teacher and principal, Katie Donohoe. Groups are welcome to bring a picnic lunch and eat at the farm at the conclusion of the field trip.

When, where and cost?
